



HEAR Bible Study Method

Begin your reading by asking the following questions about the passage you read each day.

*Who is speaking?

*Who are they speaking to?

*What are they saying?

*When is this event occurring?

*Why are they speaking about this at this time?

*Where is this passage taking place? (Geographically and structural location)

Sometimes this information is easy to access; sometimes, it may take digging.

This will be an adventure! The greatest one of your life!

HEAR Journals:

Using a journal, write the responses to the HEAR method as you study scripture passages.

H (Highlight) - Highlight the scripture that stood out to you in this reading. Please write it down, and remember to include the address for the scripture.

E (Explain) - Explain what this scripture means.

An (Apply)-How does this scripture apply to your daily walk with Christ?

R (Respond/Reflect) - Respond and/or Reflect. Be obedient. Act in prayer first, and then move as the Holy Spirit leads. You may act in several ways, repentance, forgiveness, giving, caring, loving, etc. Write your action item and share it with a trusted accountability partner.
